



## Year 4 Curriculum Flyer Autumn term 1

Please read the following information to find out about your child's learning this half-term

In **English** we are reading 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. We will focus on developing our vocabulary by focusing on description within the text. We will then move onto describing a character's thoughts and feelings using inference during various parts of the text which will form a diary entry. We will also be exploring character viewpoints and relationships within the text.

In **Maths** we are learning about place value, identifying the value of a number up to a 5 digit number. We will be comparing and ordering numbers up to 10,000 as well as finding more and less than a given number. We will be focusing our times tables knowing the 3,4,6 off by heart.

In **Science** we are learning about animals including humans. We will begin by looking at about our bodies, what makes up the digestive system along with their functions. We will be looking at our teeth, their names and functions. Finally we will look at food chains and the roles which make it up, the producer, predator and prey.

*Our wider curriculum work will include...*

**Humanities:** In this unit, Year 4 will explore who the Ancient Egyptians were, what they did and discuss whether Ancient Egypt deserves its reputation as one of the most important early civilisations.

**Art/DT:** The children will be creating sculptures out of clay and Modroc to form an Egyptian Mummy. They will also be developing their sketching skills.

**RE:** The children will be looking into Hinduism and Diwali .
