



Year 5 Curriculum Flyer Autumn term 1

Please read the following information to find out about your child's learning this half-term

In **English** we are reading 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' by Roald Dahl. We will focus on character development; physically and personality. Through drama we will experience the boat journey to the Invention Room. We will be using alliteration, personification and descriptive language in the Invention Room to create a new amazing sweet. Also creating atmosphere in our writing.

In **Maths** we are reading, writing and ordering numbers up to 1,000,000; partitioning and counting forwards and backwards. Also we will be reading Roman Numerals up to 1,000. We will also be adding and subtracting with 4 digit numbers, including formal written method. We will continue to practice our timestables.

In **Science** are topic is 'Animals and Humans'. We will be describing the changes as humans develop to old age such as growth and development. Also we will work scientifically by researching gestation periods of other animals and comparing them with humans, by finding out and recording the length and mass of a baby.

Our wider curriculum work will include...

Humanities: Ancient Greece; evaluate how Ancient Greece left a legacy and compare a town in Greece to Mansfield.

Art: Capturing photos of different themes and aspects of images. Hold a photography exhibition.

D&T: Using air drying clay to create and make their own Greek pottery and make a class display.

RE: Sikhism; Places of worship

Music: Focused around: 'Livin' On A Prayer' by Bon Jovi; learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song.
