Dear Parents and Carers,



Parent Communication

Following conversations from our coffee mornings, we will be transitioning from Weduc to a new parent communication system called Class Dojo next half term

We believe that Class Dojo will enhance communication between parents and their child's class teacher, making it easier for you to stay informed about your child's progress.

During the holidays, we kindly request that you create a Class Dojo account by downloading the app from App store or by using the web browser.

Weduc will still be available for a few days after the half term to ensure a smooth transition and avoid any missed parent communication.



Currently, our school attendance stands at 92.6%, and we are continually striving to improve it to ensure our students' optimal learning and development.

Unfortunately, persistent lateness remains a challenge. It is important to note that when a child arrives late to school, it not only disrupts their morning but also diverts valuable personnel resources away from other school activities.

Additionally, if your child arrives after the registers close, they will receive a 'U' mark, which affects their attendance percentage.

Falling below 90% triggers attendance monitoring.
